



Screenwriting/Film Class

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The description of the class is as follows,

This course explores the communication between writers, director & actors (writers in the class are the same as the actors). Students will focus on how writers and director's vision translates into playable action on the screen. Class sessions will provide examples & practical experience in writing a script from start to finish. Each group will work on three different storylines. Students will write three scripts. From those three scripts students will choose one and revise it. After the revisions are completed the students will work on their character in the movie and begin to memorize their lines. Additionally each group will choose a director in their own group to work with our main director (Jeff Gottlieb- <http://www.imdb.com/name/nm0331976/>) to translate their idea on to the screen.

Students will receive a schedule of the shooting date(s) of their film. After the entire project is completed students will have the opportunity to debut their films in our first annual St. Finn Barr Film Festival. Additionally students will have the opportunity to enter their short films into various film festivals across the country. Of course this will require parental permission slip.

This class is open to 5th-8th grade students.
